Vocabulary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Advanced lexical enhancement featuring a range of familiar and unfamiliar topics • Collocations, idioms and colloquialisms • Register (formal, informal, vulgar, etc.) • Discourse markers: adverbs, adverbial expressions ; • Gradable adjectives • "Get" & "have": advanced uses and expressions, idioms and collocations • Phrasal verbs • Advanced word-building (suffixes, past participle verbs, adjectives, abstract nouns, etc.)
Pronunciation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Basic phonetics; focus on problematic sounds • Intonation, rhythm, word & sentence stress (strong vs. weak syllables) and features of connected speech (elision, linking sounds, etc.) • Familiarisation with a variety of accents

Pre-requisite: Students should have completed the B2 level.
