The course involves synchronous and asynchronous activities and homework, using the text book, <b>English File Digital Gold C1 (4th Edition) Student's Book, Workbook &amp; e-Book: Level C1</b> , plus other digital and online materials. The course is highly interactive and activities are varied and student-centred.

Permission, obligation and necessity</li> <li>• Relative clauses</li> <li>• Sentence structure (e.g. verb patterns, noun clauses; cleft sentences; participle clauses)</li> </ul>
<b>Vocabulary</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Advanced lexical enhancement with a range of familiar and unfamiliar topics</li> <li>• Collocations, idioms and colloquialisms, phrasal verbs</li> <li>• Register (e.g. formal, informal, vulgar, etc.)</li> <li>• Discourse markers: adverbs, adverbial expressions ;</li> <li>• Prepositional phrases</li> <li>• Prefixes and compound nouns/adjectives</li> <li>• Advanced word building</li> </ul>
<b>Pronunciation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Further elements of practical phonetics; focus on problematic sounds</li> <li>• Intonation, rhythm, word &amp; sentence stress (strong vs. weak syllables) and features of connected speech (elision, linking sounds, etc.)</li> <li>• Familiarisation with a variety of accents</li> </ul>
